


God's Plan of Salvation

- Confess faith in Christ (Romans 10:9-10)
- Be baptized (immersed) into Christ for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; Romans 6:1-11)

A Personal Welcome

We welcome you to the Brighton Church of Christ. You are our guest and we want you to know that we are honored to have you visit with us. We hope your experience with us will be uplifting and encouraging and that you will come again soon. In case this is your first time to visit a congregation of the Church of Christ, we want to share with you a little more information about who we are as followers of Jesus Christ.

Who Are We?

The Brighton Church of Christ is made up of Christians who seek to serve Jesus Christ in a non-denominational fellowship of believers who are united because of our common faith and practice. We accept the Bible as our only guide as we strive to be nothing more and nothing less than followers of Jesus.

Organizational Structure

Each congregation of the Church of Christ is autonomous (self-governed) and has no national or international headquarters. Congregations select spiritual men who meet Scriptural qualifications to serve as elders or spiritual shepherds of the local congregation. Deacons serve to direct and administer specific ministries of the church. While a congregation may have a local minister or evangelist, each Christian is considered to be responsible for sharing the gospel of Jesus with others.

Our Worship

Our worship is simple. Following the example of the early church, our worship consists of singing acappella, a weekly observance of the Lord's Supper, fellowship in prayer, studying Scripture, and sharing our material gifts through collectively giving to support good works.

The Bible, Our Authority

We accept the Bible as the inspired, infallible Word of God and as our sole authority in faith and practice. We have no man written creed. The Old Testament was God's covenant with his people before the coming of Christ. The New Testament replaced the old covenant by providing a new covenant relationship with Him through His Son, Jesus Christ. The New Testament contains God's plan for salvation.

Church Membership

Becoming a member of the church of Christ is the same as becoming a Christian. Nothing further is required. When one is baptized by immersion into the death of Jesus through faith and repentance from sins, that person becomes a part of the body of Christ, the church. The New Testament is our guide for becoming a Christian and for living the Christian life. In other words, one who hears the gospel, believes that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, repents of his or her sins, confesses that faith, and is buried with Christ through immersion is saved and thereby added to the church. Only a person who is old enough to understand and believe the gospel is a candidate for baptism.

Our Clothing Ministry

Every Tuesday starting at 3 p.m., we open our doors to people in need and offer various clothing items, household items, books and toys at no cost. We accept donations from the community from 9-4 Monday-Saturday. If you know of someone or a family in need, please let them know about this ministry. Remember everything is free.

Our Spiritual Heritage

Our attempt is to by-pass all human religious organizations and denominations and duplicate New Testament Christianity today. This effort to restore the early church is not new and is not unique to the United States. Wherever students of scripture respond to the gospel as set forth in the New Testament and create a community of believers whose worship and faith are patterned after that of the New Testament believers, a Church of Christ is formed. Millions of Christians around the world are part of this fellowship.
